Application deadline is **June 1, 2020**, but it is advisable to apply early since quotas & preferred spaces fill rapidly.  
**Please, to avoid delays and possible rejection of your application, read the entire form.**

On **Saturday, November 28** the 45<sup>th</sup> annual craft market will take place at the **Saratoga Springs City Center from 10am-4:30pm** and we invite you to apply to be an artisan. In order to secure the highest quality crafters, we encourage you to apply now so we can jury with the best selection. We have craft quotas on several items. Crafters will be chosen on quality, uniqueness, variety, postmark & booth display. Booth placement is chosen on the same criteria. **You must apply by May 1st to be considered for your 2019 booth assignment.** Note: We obtain our best new crafters from your recommendations.

### This craft fair is a juried show, please complete the following steps in your application

- Complete and detach the form at the bottom of the page and mail with your check & the required materials.
- **New Crafters:** Please enclose photos of your craft, your display and you, the artisan, producing the product along with a list of prices. Incomplete applications will be returned. You may submit your photos via [photos@saratogacraft.org](mailto:photos@saratogacraft.org). Photos are not required for 2019 exhibitors unless you have a new product line.
- **Acceptances will be emailed.** Snail mail crafters please include a stamped self-addressed envelope.

### Please also note:

- This juried show is open only to exhibitors who **themselves** make the **handcrafted items**. **No catalog items**. Exhibitors not complying with this rule will be asked to leave.
- **Food vendors:** Please visit [www.saratogacraft.org/foodguidelines.pdf](http://www.saratogacraft.org/foodguidelines.pdf) to review the City Center's food exhibiting policy. **Please note: Coffee/muffins sold in exhibit hall from 8AM to 9:30AM.**
- Prepaid reservations are required-checks only, no cash. A \$60.00 fee will be charged for cancellations. Cancellations received within six (6) weeks of the event are not granted a refund- **no exceptions**.
- End booths are assigned on a high-juried result including booth presentation.
- Exhibitors may begin to set up at 7:00 AM (no prior setup).
- Chairs and 8' x 30" tables are available at no additional charge. **No reservation needed.** Tables must be covered to the floor. **Booth appearance is so important- please refrain from flat table presentation.**

### Exhibitor fees: (Additional \$20.00 late registration fee\* for applications postmarked after June 1, 2020):

- Basic spaces (approx. 10'frontage x 8'depth) are \$145.00 (\$165.00\*)
- Large spaces (approx. 15'frontage x 8'depth) are \$215.00 (\$235.00\*)
